

Summary in Isaszeg

24/10 2022 Monday

The first day of the mobility was travelling day. In the evening the host families were waiting for the Polish group at the school, the coordinator greeted the guests, then the families took them home.

25/10/2022 Tuesday

The day started with greeting the guests in their "Erasmus classroom". Some of primary and SEN students came and sang an English song to say hello to the guests. It was a great opportunity to involve those who are not able to participate in a mobility abroad as well as SEN students.

After that, a School Treasure Hunt took place: students were divided into small groups with mixed nationality. They had to find some places or some pieces of information about the school together. (task sheet find attached). During the next workshop the students presented about their countries, cities and school traditions. The main point of that day was a local history excursion by Isaszeg, where the Hungarian students were the tourist guides and they introduced the historical places of their town. During the trip, they visited the local House of Culture where a national folk dance was performed for them. At the end of the day all the students have dinner together in a restaurant where traditional Hungarian dishes were served. That day all the students got a lot of information about Hungarian history, folklore and local traditions.

26/10/2022 Wednesday

Two workshops went parallel:

-Creative workshop: students painted Isaszeg folk motifs on a pencil case made of linen. It was an environment friendly solution to get them know about the folk motifs and create a gift for themselves at the same time.

-Works of art come to life: students got a typical Hungarian painting, make up and some traditional clothes. Their task was to recreate the scene in the painting using props. In this way they also got a brief insight into Hungarian art.

After the group finished one workshop they changed to another one.

After that the Polish student participated in a Hungarian language lesson and a sport competition.

That afternoon they visited the mayor of Isaszeg who told them a lot about the traditional friendship between Hungarian and Polish people and about the Polish sister town of Isaszeg.

27/10/2022 Thursday

In the morning the two groups presented the pop song that their community consider a "rock anthem". As we believe that the pop music is also a part of the culture of a nation, it was important to show that the pop music also can be a tool to connect the people.

Next workshop was a competition about native animals. Students used tablets in groups and they got information about native Hungarian animals based on a task sheet.

This activity was followed by a short competition on the topic then students started to get ready for the closing event: the posters and presentations were created to summarize the last days.

In the evening the closing event was held: we invited all the students and teachers who participated as well as the host families. After the students' report we handed in the certificates of attendance.

Finally, all the guest of this party danced together Hungarian folk dances led by one of the Hungarian teachers. After the folk dance the students started to dance modern dances together so the party ended in a really warm, friendly atmosphere.

After the official meeting, 12 Hungarian and 3 Polish teachers had dinner together in a local restaurant. That was a good opportunity to have informal talks and get to know each other better.

28/10/2022 Friday

It was the last day of the meeting in Hungary. The whole group of Hungarian and Polish students and teachers went on a tour to Budapest. The Hungarian students guided the tour and they visited most of attractions of Budapest such as Castle of Vajdahunyad, Heroes' Square, Buda Castle, Church of Matias, Fisherman's Bastion and the Rock Hospital. In the evening they finished the tour with a boat trip on the river Danube.

29/10/2022 Saturday

The Polish group travelled home.

In addition to school activities, the families organised many other activities for the students.
